## MATT CASH TAKES THE PRIZE ON SECOND

orth Carolina bricklayer Matt Cash, age 35, took first place and the title "World's Best Bricklayer" at the 15th annual SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500 World Championship. Held January 18, 2017 in Las Vegas during the 2017 World of Concrete show, the event drew the largest crowd of masonry fans ever.

Cash laid 716 brick in 60 minutes for the win, which earned him

the keys to a 2017 Ford F-250 XLT 4x4 truck and \$15,000 in cash and prizes. He won the competition on his second attempt, aided by brick tender Chet Huntley, who is also his boss at Huntley Brothers Company in Mint Hill, North Carolina. Earlier that day, Huntley, 45, won the SPEC MIX TOUGHEST TENDER competition, also defeating 24 other competitors.

Cash and Huntley trained up for two months before the event, building

10 competition walls — after full days of laying brick on project sites. In addition to the new Ford F-250 truck, Cash's prize package included a \$5,000 check, a trophy and tools and accessories from Blakladder, Gatorback, iQ Power tools, Marshalltown, Stabila and Stihl.

Over the last 15 years, the SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500 has become a main event at the World of Concrete as a showcase for the rock stars of the bricklaying craft and offers the trade a forum for its craft and practitioners.
